

### Virtues -

## This week's virtue is "Responsibility".

**Foundation stage -** This week we have been talking about bonfire night and thinking of words to describe the sounds of the fireworks for example, bang, pop and wizz.

On Wednesday all the children walked down the Church to look at the building, we talked about what special celebrations are held in Churches, Christmas services, weddings, and christenings. The children were all very well behaved a real credit to you all.

In maths this week the Reception children have been learning to partition numbers to 3, 2+1, 3+0 please practise this at home using toys or cubes. The Nursery children have enjoyed using musical instruments to follow patterns and play them loudly and quietly.

We have focused on the number 1, completing actions 1 jump, 1 stamp, the children have also been hunting for the number 1 around the classroom.

## **Key Stage 1**

**Year 1** - Year 1 were an absolute pleasure to take to St Michael's Mount at the start of the week. They loved exploring and seeing the different artefacts. They loved finding the giant's heart and the giant's well along the way. Their challenges this week have all been linked to the trip including building a model of the mount and writing about their trip. In Forest School today they have been identifying different parts of a flower. The next Forest School session is on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> November.

**Year 2-** The children had a fantastic day at St. Michael's Mount on Monday. They walked for miles with very few complaints! Their behaviour was brilliant. We were so proud of them. In Geography this week, the children were able to write their own address onto a postcard understanding what the postcode was and its importance. Look out next week for something popping through your letterbox! The most exciting news is that we have started practising for the school Christmas Play. The children have been given their parts and scripts have been sent home. I would be grateful if you could help your child learn their lines and practise singing the songs. Mrs Tripp is currently sorting costumes. If we need any extra we will be in touch.

## **Key Stage 2**

**Year 3/4 -** This week, we started our new history focus, Stone to Steel and looked at the Stone Age and the start of the Bronze Age. Did you know that the Stone Age lasted for nearly 3 million years? We have started practicing the Christmas carols and they will be performing these at the Christmas Fair, opening the event at 2pm. Please pop the date in your diary and join us if you can.

The children have looked at many news related items this week – COP26 and Remembrance. Your children have created class, school and community ideas supporting climate change and so they may be asking you to support them in some of these in future months.

Homework will start again today after the half term break, now that they have completed a new element of learning.

**Year 5/6 -** Year 5/6 have had another busy week. The children are really ended with their geography topic on volcanoes and have produced diagrams to show the parts of a volcano- ask your child if they can name any for you. In literacy, following on from our science learning on life cycles, we are writing explanation texts about the lifecycle of a praying mantis- if you discuss this with them, they may be able to tell you about the three stages.
