Foundation stage

This week the children have been listening to the Christmas story and sequencing pictures. The Reception children have had a go at writing words and caption to go with the pictures.

In phonics, the Reception children have been looking at double ff, ss and II at the end of words writing and segmenting and

blending sounds in words. The Nursery children have been developing their understanding of alliteration, they have been playing the game silly soup adding items to the soup e.g in goes a bumblebee, bug, and banana.

In maths we have been ordering numbers from 1-5 or 1-10 and making our own track games.
